AFCA is excited to announce the winner of the Regional African Taste of Harvest Competition held at the AFCA Specialty Coffee Expo in Zanzibar from 29-30 October 2019. The competition followed the Cupping Form and Protocols of the Coffee Quality Institute (CQI) Specialty Arabica Coffees, to identify and select the absolute best coffees from Tanzania in 2019. Samples were submitted by coffee producers, cooperatives, millers and exporters from Tanzania, Zambia and Cameroon to be cupped, graded and judged by a panel of qualified and experienced international and local judges.

**Taylor Winch (Tanzania) Ltd wins the Regional African Taste of Harvest Competition with an Arabica AA/AB Kent and Bourbon variety scoring 85.9 points from the Amkeni Farmers Group on the slopes of Kilimanjaro.**
