

KENYA TASTE OF HARVEST CALL FOR SAMPLES !!!



The African Fine Coffees Association (AFCA) will hold the Kenya Taste of Harvest an annual prestigious specialty coffee grading competition, from 9-12 February 2021 at the AFA Coffee Directorate in Nairobi, Kenya.

AFCA calls for all coffee producers, cooperatives, millers and exporters in Kenya to submit their finest Arabica coffee samples to the Taste of Harvest competition. All samples will be cupped, graded and judged by a panel of qualified and experienced international and local judges, using the Coffee Quality Institute (CQI) and Specialty Coffee Association (SCA) Specialty Arabica Coffees Cupping Form and Protocols, to identify and select the absolute best coffees from Kenya in 2021.

Taste of Harvest Rules & Regulations:

The quality of the samples submitted should be Specialty Arabica Grade with a cupping score of 83 points and above. 8kg Green coffee beans should be duly packed and submitted with a complete and detailed Sample Identification Form (on the right), a Warehouse Receipt as proof of export lot availability, USD50 Non Member Sample Entry/Proof of Payment and 3x High Resolution Images and Logo promoting the coffee. 3kg of hulled green coffee is required for the national and regional competitions. 5kg of AFCA member winning coffees will be showcased and promoted at AFCA's annual regional coffee conferences, leading international coffee cuppings, trade fairs and expo's in Europe, America, Middle East, Australia and Asia. All samples submitted must be a true representation of its lot. Minimum exportable lot size is 5 bags and maximum is 25 bags of 60kg per bag. Storage in Grainpro/Ecotact bags are recommended. Sample requests from international buyers will be drawn directly from the winning lots in its warehouses.

AFCA may publicise, share and promote any tools, manuals, materials, photos, content and information developed during this event for marketing purposes through its social media, marketing material, websites, databases and auction platforms et al.
